Subject: Winter Parking

Dear Members,

It is with regret that we must inform you that we have not been issued a parking lot lease and have been denied the use of our parking lot by the Forest Service. The interstate construction project will be using some of the Crystal Springs area for the improvement of I-90 that is already underway.

All guests and residents of the area will be required to purchase State of Washington snow park permits and will be required to park in the [Crystal Springs](#) main lot. You may purchase the permits after November 1st at [various locations](#) in Washington. Information is available on-line at <http://www.parks.wa.gov/winter/permits/>

We want to point out that you will be required to purchase the groomed trail permit when parking at the Crystal Springs snow park. If you are not purchasing the season pass, you need to **purchase a day pass for each of the days you will be staying, including the groomed trail permit**. For those who are planning on arriving Saturday or Sunday mornings you will need to plan on arriving early because the parking lot is shared with the snowmobile crowd and when the lot is full the park Rangers turn people away. Some of you already use a bus and this may be an option for some of the larger groups.

Again, we regret this development but we will still be picking everyone up with the snow cat and we want to assure you that, as always, we will do our best to help you have a fun and pleasant experience at [Trollhaugen](#) - [map](#).
