District Two Sons of Norway is pleased to announce that the Carl M. Saltveit Scholarship Fund will provide \$2800 in assistance to a qualified applicant to attend the International Summer School at the University of Oslo in Oslo, Norway during the summer of 2009. This permanently endowed fund provides one scholarship annually to encourage and facilitate attendance at the International Summer School. Any member in good standing of Sons of Norway District Two, as well as their children or grandchildren, are eligible to apply. You do not have to be currently enrolled in school. Anyone who has completed one full year of collage level work is eligible to apply.

The scholarship is named for Carl M. Saltveit, Sr, in honor and remembrance of his contributions to the Norwegian-American Community through Greig Lodge #15 (Portland, Oregon), his work in Norwegian war relief, educational exchange and services to immigrants and visitors from Norway. In addition, he served as an International Director of the Sons of Norway.

The District Two Scholarship Committee will choose the top three candidates and forward their applications, along with a recommendation, to the Sons of Norway foundation. The Foundation will select to recipient and administer the scholarship.
